6 A resolution suspending the City's recycling program until a new contract
7 can be re-negotiated to include green waste, large cans, and recycling.
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9 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a solid waste disposal contract with
10 Waste Management of St. Tammany;
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12 WHEREAS, the contract includes a recycling program; and
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14 WHEREAS, both the market for recyclable goods and citizen participation
15 in that program has decreased over the years; and
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17 WHEREAS, Waste Management of St. Tammany has indicated that it
18 would like to renegotiate its entire contract with the City; and
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20 WHEREAS, Waste Management of St. Tammany has offered the City new
21 and additional services in a new contract; and
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
23 WHEREAS, such a new contract could be financially and environmentally
24 beneficial to the City and its citizens; and
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26 WHEREAS, said new contract would also include a realistic recycling
27 program.
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30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council
31 authorizes the suspension of the existing recycling program for a period of 90 days or
32 until a new solid waste disposal contract (to include green waste, recycling, large
33 cans and automated pickup service) can be negotiated, whichever occurs first.
