WHEREAS, the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals has ruled on June 26, 2002 that the inclusion of the words "Under God" in the Pledge of Allegiance is unconstitutional; and

WHEREAS, this decision affects the states of Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, and Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to join our fellow citizens in the western United States in dealing with this issue until its hopeful reversal by the United States Supreme Court; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council recites the nation's Pledge of Allegiance at the beginning of each meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Council feels it is important to keep intact the present text of the Pledge that was adopted in 1954.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby oppose the 9th Circuit's decision and urges the United States Supreme Court to overturn this ruling.
