8 A resolution supporting the proposed constitutional amendment relating to
9 state supplemental pay for police officers.

11 WHEREAS, on November 5, 2002, the voters of Louisiana will be asked
12 to decide whether State supplemental pay for law enforcement officers and firefighters
13 should be protected by the constitution; and

15 WHEREAS, such payment by the State relieves some financial burdens
16 from the City; and

18 WHEREAS, law enforcement officers and firefighters are traditionally and
19 generally underpaid;

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
23 supports proposed constitutional amendment no. 6 relative to State supplemental pay
24 for law enforcement officers and firefighters.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council urges all
28 registered voters to go to the polls on November 5, 2002 and consider supporting the
29 proposed amendment.
