5 **RESOLUTION NO. R03-03**

7 A resolution requesting the City Administration to place a six-month
8 moratorium on allowing the location of mobile homes, manufactured homes, or trailer
9 homes within District A so that all aspects of this issue may be studied.

10 WHEREAS, Slidell Council District A is the only District in the City of
11 Slidell that allows the location of mobile homes, manufactured homes, or trailer homes;
12

15 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition signed by
16 residents of Slidell Council District A, asking that a moratorium be placed on allowing
17
18 mobile homes, manufactured homes, or trailer homes in District A; and

20 WHEREAS, said residents have expressed concerns regarding property
21 values being lowered because of the location of mobile homes, manufactured homes,
22
23 or trailer homes in District A; and

25 WHEREAS, any changes in the law must go before the Planning and
26 Zoning Commission for a recommendation to the City Council; and



28 WHEREAS, a six-month moratorium would give the Administration and
29 the Planning and Zoning Commission sufficient time to study and recommend any
30 amendment to the zoning ordinance.

35 the location of mobile homes, manufactured homes, or trailer homes within District A.
