## **RESOLUTION R03-08**

A resolution placing a six-month moratorium on the contractor testing requirements as established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7.

WHEREAS, the City has requirements for contractor testing as established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Building and Building Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration uses an outside testing company for contractor testing; and

WHEREAS, this testing company is now requesting the City sign a contractual agreement, thereby guaranteeing them monthly payments regardless if we have applicants or not; and

WHEREAS, the City has averaged only six to eight applicants per year; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration feels it is not economically feasible for the City to enter into this agreement based upon such historical low usage; and

WHEREAS, a six-month moratorium would give the Administration sufficient time to study the matter and make a recommendation to the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby place a six-month moratorium on the contractor testing requirements as established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Building and Building Regulations.
