7 A resolution placing a six-month moratorium on the contractor testing
8 requirements as established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7.
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10 WHEREAS, the City has requirements for contractor testing as
11 established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Building and Building Regulations;

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15 WHEREAS, the City Administration uses an outside testing company for
16 contractor testing; and
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18 WHEREAS, this testing company is now requesting the City sign a
19 contractual agreement, thereby guaranteeing them monthly payments regardless if we
20 have applicants or not; and
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23 WHEREAS, the City has averaged only six to eight applicants per year;
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25 and

26 WHEREAS, the City Administration feels it is not economically feasible for
27 the City to enter into this agreement based upon such historical low usage; and
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29 WHEREAS, a six-month moratorium would give the Administration
30 sufficient time to study the matter and make a recommendation to the City Council.
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32 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
33 does hereby place a six-month moratorium on the contractor testing requirements as
34 established in the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Building and Building Regulations.
