## **RESOLUTION R03-34**

A resolution requesting the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) reactivate the lights along Pontchartrain Drive and Front Street that are currently on blinking status.

WHEREAS, as part of an effort to upgrade traffic lights in the area DOTD concluded that a few traffic signals located between Front Street and Pontchartrain Drive were not necessary; and

WHEREAS, these intersections include Front Street at Robert Street, Pontchartrain Drive at Carey Street, Pontchartrain Drive at Clara Street, and Pontchartrain Drive at Broad Street; and

WHEREAS, these lights are currently in a blinking mode and will remain that way for approximately 90 days; and

WHEREAS, DOTD has stated that after 90 days if it is concluded that the lights are still not necessary, these lights will be removed; and

WHEREAS, when these lights were placed on blinking status around July 22, 2003, school was out and traffic in the area was much lighter; and

WHEREAS, traffic has increased in the area due to schools being open; and WHEREAS, Senator Tom Schedler and Representative A. G. Crowe have expressed their support of returning the traffic signals to active status.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request DOTD reactivate the traffic lights along Pontchartrain Drive and Front Street that are currently on blinking status.
