4 **VERBAL RESOLUTION R03-02**

6 A resolution urging the St. Tammany Parish Legislative delegation to support  
7 the bill before the Legislature requiring highway work to be performed at night and during  
8 other non-peak hours.

9 WHEREAS, traffic in and around the City of Slidell was brought to a virtual  
10 standstill over the weekend of June 7th and 8th, due to the closure of one lane of  
11 Interstate 10 between the City of Slidell and the Mississippi State line; and

14 WHEREAS, it appears this problem will continue until the project is completed  
15 weeks or months from now; and  
16

17 WHEREAS, this gridlock not only affects the quality of life for our citizens, but  
18 also is expected to adversely affect our sales tax revenues; and

21 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council recognizes that this problem would be  
22 greatly reduced or eliminated entirely if the construction work is done at night or during  
23 time periods where traffic is lighter.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does  
26 hereby call upon the members of its St. Tammany Parish Legislative delegation to support  
27 legislation that requires highway work to be performed at night and during other non-peak  
28 hours.
