## **RESOLUTION R04-02**

A resolution amending Resolution R02-20, adopted September 10, 2002, supplementing the City's application to the State Bond Commission and to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality for approval of the issuance by the City of Slidell (the "City") of not to exceed \$4,100,000 of Utility Revenue Notes for the purpose of financing the cost of construction, improvement, rehabilitation and expansion of the City's Terrace Avenue Wastewater Treatment Plant.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), did adopt Bond Resolution R02-20 on September 10, 2002 (the "Original Bond Resolution"), which was captioned as follows:

A resolution making application to the State Bond Commission and to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality for approval of the issuance by the City of Slidell (the "City") of not to exceed \$3,500,000 of Utility Revenue Notes for the purpose of financing the cost of construction, improvement, rehabilitation and expansion of the City's Terrace Avenue Wastewater Treatment Plant.

and

WHEREAS, the Original Bond Resolution authorized the issuance of not exceeding \$3,500,000 of City of Slidell, State of Louisiana Utility Revenue Notes, Series 2003 (collectively, the "Notes") to finance the rehabilitation, improvement and expansion of the City's Terrace Avenue Facility; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the cost of the improvements to the City's Terrace Avenue Facility have increased and, accordingly, it will be necessary to increase the aggregate principal amount of the Notes to be issued pursuant to the Original Bond Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to supplement and amend the Original Bond Resolution to increase the aggregate principal amount of the Notes from not exceeding \$3,500,000 to not exceeding \$4,100,000, and to provide for other related matters;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City Council"), acting as the governmental authority of the City, that:

SECTION 1. <u>Preliminary Approval of Notes</u>. Section 1 of the Original bond Resolution (Resolution R02-20) be and it is hereby amended in the following respects: (1) by changing and increasing the maximum aggregate amount of the Notes from \$3,500,000 to \$4,100,000, and (2) by changing the series designation of the Notes to read as follows: "not exceeding \$4,100,000 aggregate principal amount of City of Slidell, State of Louisiana Utility Revenue Notes, Series 2004."

SECTION 2. State Bond Commission Application. Section 2 of the Original Bond Resolution is hereby amended to authorize the submission of a supplemental application to the State Bond Commission, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, for final approval of the issuance by the City of the Notes in the increased aggregate principal amount of \$4,100,000 in accordance with the other parameters set forth in the Original Bond Resolution. In connection herewith, a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission.

SECTION 3. MFRLF Application. Section 3 of the Original Bond Resolution is hereby amended to authorize the submission of a supplemental application to the Municipal Facilities Revolving Loan Fund of the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (the "MFRLF") reflecting the increase in the aggregate principal amount of the Notes to \$4,100,000.

SECTION 4. <u>Ratification and Approval</u>. Except as supplemented and amended as set forth above, the Original Bond Resolution is now ratified, approved, confirmed and carried forward in each and every respect, and all obligations created and arising thereunder, as supplemented and amended hereby, shall henceforth be and remain in full force and effect.
