7 A resolution of the Slidell City Council endorsing the renewal of a \$10 million  
8 dollar bond to construct the Northshore Harbor Center.

9 WHEREAS, in 1998 voters said "yes" to a \$10 million dollar bond issue to  
10 construct the Northshore Harbor Center, formerly known as the East St. Tammany Events  
11 Center; and

14 WHEREAS, this facility will be used for school performances, recitals,  
15 business meetings, banquets, graduations, Mardi Gras events, weddings, concerts, craft  
16 and boat shows, athletic events, home and garden shows, trade shows and conventions;

21 WHEREAS, this is a renewal of a bond that taxpayers passed in 1998 and  
22 there will be no increase in tax rates; and

24 WHEREAS, this renewal will allow Eastern St. Tammany to have a fully  
25 equipped facility complete with dividing walls for meeting flexibility and elevated seating for  
26 performing arts and sporting events; and

29 WHEREAS, the first 30,000 square feet are under construction and will be  
30 completed in the spring 2005; and


32 WHEREAS, the Northshore Harbor Center will enhance and improve the
