5 A resolution of the Slidell City Council endorsing Earth Day Northshore as a  
6 City-sponsored event.

8 WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 3165 on February 10,  
9  
10 2004, which required that any events sponsored by the City of Slidell be approved jointly  
11 by the Mayor and the Council; and

13 WHEREAS, the procedure involves the completion of a "City-Sponsored  
14 Event" application by the entity seeking sponsorship; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the form is then sent to various department heads as  
17 determined by the Administration in order to provide internal cost estimates and availability  
18 of labor and accommodations for said event; and

21 WHEREAS, the form is then forwarded to the Mayor for his approval or  
22 denial; and

24 WHEREAS, upon the Mayor's approval the form is forwarded to the Council  
25 for consideration by Resolution.

27 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it  
28 does hereby concur with the recommendation by the Administration to endorse Earth Day  
29 Northshore as a City-sponsored event.
