8 A resolution placing a moratorium on the future construction of fences in
9 commercial zoning districts within the City for a period of ninety (90) days.


10 WHEREAS, issues relating to the future construction of fences in commercial
11 zones within the City have recently arisen; and

13 WHEREAS, the City's Zoning Code does not fully address such issues; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the City requires a certain period of time within which to study the
16 issues and formulate necessary and proper amendments to the Zoning Code.

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that a
19 moratorium is hereby imposed on the future construction of fences in commercial zoning
20 districts within the City for a period of ninety (90) days. This moratorium shall be effective
21 upon adoption by the Council.
