## **RESOLUTION R04-14**

A resolution placing a moratorium on the future construction of fences in commercial zoning districts within the City for a period of ninety (90) days.

WHEREAS, the City's Zoning Code does not fully address such issues; and

WHEREAS, the City requires a certain period of time within which to study the issues and formulate necessary and proper amendments to the Zoning Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that a moratorium is hereby imposed on the future construction of fences in commercial zoning districts within the City for a period of ninety (90) days. This moratorium shall be effective upon adoption by the Council.
