4 **RESOLUTION R04-19**

6 A resolution requesting the LA DOTD provide the ten percent (10%) matching
7 funds for replacing the I-12 sound barrier in Slidell, adjacent to the Country Club Estates
8 development.

9 WHEREAS, Resolution R02-26 was adopted October 8, 2002, by the Slidell
10 City Council, requesting the United States Congress to appropriate funds for the
11 construction of sound barriers along Interstate 12 in Slidell; and

14 WHEREAS, the U. S. Congress appropriated \$750,000 in the Federal
15 Omnibus Bill for the sole purpose of relieving the noise pollution produced along Interstate
16 12 in Slidell, adjacent to the Country Club Estates development; and

19 WHEREAS, the current wooden noise barrier was constructed in 1985 and is
20 insufficient in handling the noise due to the increase in traffic volume; and


22 WHEREAS, the LA DOTD recently replaced missing boards in the fence and
23 in doing so removed the bushes and small trees, which has added to the noise problem
24 and has exposed the fence; and

27 WHEREAS, Senator Tom Schedler has requested that LA DOTD provide the
28 required 10% state match to the \$750,000 of federal funds to complete this project.
29

30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
31 hereby request the LA DOTD provide the ten percent (10%) matching funds for replacing
32 the I-12 sound barrier in Slidell, adjacent to the Country Club Estates development.
