11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council (the "Governing Authority"),
12 acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

14 SECTION 1. Election Call. Subject to the approval of the State Bond
15 Commission, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Sections 30 and 32 of the
16 Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, the applicable provisions of Chapter 5 and
17 Chapter 6-A of the Louisiana Election Code, and other constitutional and statutory
18 authority, a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Slidell on
19 **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2004**, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m., and eight
20 o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, and at the said
21 election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the
22 said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the Constitution of the
23 United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

25 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, levy a five (5) mills tax
26 on all property subject to taxation in said City for a period of ten (10)
27 years, beginning with the year 2006 and ending with the year 2015,
28 for the purpose of constructing and maintaining garbage disposal
29 works and refuse and garbage collection and disposal systems
30 within and for the City?

31 SECTION 2. Publication of Notice of Election. A Notice of Special Election
32 shall be published in the *Daily Sentry News*, a daily newspaper of general circulation within
33 the City of Slidell, published in Slidell, Louisiana, and being the official journal of the City of
34 Slidell, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not
35 less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date of the

4 election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and
5
6 incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

7 SECTION 3. Canvass. This Governing Authority shall meet at its regular
8
9 meeting place, the City Hall, 2055 Second Street, Slidell, Louisiana, on **TUESDAY,**
10 **NOVEMBER 16, 2004,** at **SIX-THIRTY O’CLOCK (6:30) P.M.,** and shall then and there in
11
12 open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the
13
14 results of the said special election.

15 SECTION 4. Polling Places. The polling places set forth in the aforesaid
16
17 Notice of Special Election are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the
18
19 said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be
20
21 the same persons as those designated in accordance with law.

22 SECTION 5. Election Commissioners; Voting Machines. The officers
23
24 designated to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section
25
26 4 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance
27
28 with La. R.S. 18:1287, shall hold the said special election as herein provided, and shall
29
30 make due returns of said election for the meeting of the Governing Authority to be held on
31
32 Tuesday, November 16, 2004, as provided in Section 3 hereof. All registered voters in the
33
34 City will be entitled to vote at the special election, and voting machines shall be used.

35 SECTION 6. Authorization of Officers. The Clerk of the Council of the
36
37 Governing Authority is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to
38
39 furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said election, the necessary
equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the proper holding of said election

4 and the President of the Council and/or Clerk of the Council of the Governing Authority are
5 further authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action required by
6 State and/or Federal law to arrange for the election, including but not limited to,
7 appropriate submission to the Federal Department of Justice under Section 5 of the
8 Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

12 SECTION 7. Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials. Certified copies of
13 this resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Clerk of Court and *Ex-*
14 *Officio* Parish Custodian of Voting Machines of St. Tammany Parish and the Registrar of
15 Voters of St. Tammany Parish, as notification of the special election, in order that each
16 may prepare for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

20 SECTION 8. Application to State Bond Commission. Application is made to
21 the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the special election as herein
22 provided, and in the event said election carries for further consent and authority to
23 continue to levy and collect the special taxes provided for therein. A certified copy of this
24 resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission on behalf of this Governing
25 Authority, together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this
26 application.

30 SECTION 9. Approval of Governing Authority of the Parish. Application is
31 hereby made to the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, for
32 consent and authority to hold the special election as herein provided, and in the event the
33 election carries, for its further consent and authority to continue to levy and collect the


