RESOLUTION R04-35

A resolution requesting the United States Congress to enact legislation to provide tax relief to property owners who participate in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) hazard mitigation project.

WHEREAS, FEMA provides grants through state and local governments to alleviate potential damage from future natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has funded community mitigation projects affecting individual properties for over fifteen years and participating property owners generally have not paid taxes on mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2004, the IRS determined that the construction costs of a FEMA mitigation project represent income to property owners; and

WHEREAS, there is concern that owners of at-risk properties might decline to participate because of the potential tax obligation; and

WHEREAS, some property owners already bear a portion of the project cost to cover the required non-federal share; and

WHEREAS, including mitigation project construction costs as taxable income presents a potential impediment to the policy Congress sought to implement through these hazard mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, property owners who are unable to mitigate the risk to their properties due to the tax obligation remain in harm's way, and will continue to drain the National Flood Insurance Fund and the Disaster Relief Fund; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Tax Code to exclude FEMA mitigation grants from income would provide relief to owners of homes and other property in hazard-prone areas and would ensure that the objective of reducing disaster damages is accomplished.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby urge the U.S. Congress to enact legislation to exclude FEMA mitigation grants from income for property owners who participate in FEMA hazard mitigation projects.
