4 **RESOLUTION R09-31**

5
6 A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the City of
7 Slidell, State of Louisiana, amending the Home Rule Charter as proposed; making
8 application to the State Bond Commission; and providing for other matters in connection
9 therewith.

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council (the
11 "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of
12 Louisiana (the "City"), that:
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14
15 SECTION 1. Election Call. Subject to the approval of the State Bond
16 Commission, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 5(C) of the
17 Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, a special election is hereby called and
18 ordered to be held in the City of Slidell on **March 27, 2010**, between the hours of six
19 o'clock (6:00) a.m. and eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La.
20 R.S. 18:541, and at the said election there shall be submitted to all registered voters
21 qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of this
22 State and the Constitution of the United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

28 **Proposition No. 1**

29 **Summary: Provides for the deletion of the following obsolete sections.**

30 Shall the following Section 2-02(A) of the Slidell Home Rule Charter be deleted:

16 SECTION 2. Publication of Notice of Election. A Notice of Special Election
17 shall be published in the *St. Tammany News*, a newspaper which publishes three times a
18 week, of general circulation within the City of Slidell, published in Slidell, Louisiana, and
19 being the official journal of the City of Slidell, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with
20 the first publication to be made not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90)
21 days prior to the date of the election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form
22 attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were
23 set forth herein in full.

24
25 SECTION 3. Canvass. This Governing Authority shall meet at its regular
26 meeting place, the Council Chambers, 1330 Bayou Lane, Suite 110, Slidell, Louisiana, on,
27 **April 27, 2010 at SIX-THIRTY O'CLOCK (6:30) P.M.**, and shall then and there in open
28 and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of
29 the said special election.
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4 SECTION 4. Polling Places. The polling places set forth in the aforesaid
5 Notice of Special Election are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the
6 said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be
7 the same persons as those designated in accordance with law.
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10 SECTION 5. Election Commissioners; Voting Machines. The officers
11 designated to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section
12 4 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance
13 with La. R.S. 18:1287, shall hold the said special election as herein provided, and shall
14 make due returns of said election for the meeting of the Governing Authority to be held on
15 April 27, 2010, as provided in Section 3 hereof. All registered voters in the City will be
16 entitled to vote at the regular election, and voting machines shall be used.
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19 SECTION 6. Authorization of Officers. The Council Administrator of the
20 Governing Authority is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to
21 furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said election, the necessary
22 equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the proper holding of said election
23 and the President of the Council and/or Council Administrator of the Governing Authority
24 are further authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action required
25 by State and/or Federal law to arrange for the election, including but not limited to,
26 appropriate submission to the Federal Department of Justice under Section 5 of the
27 Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.
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30 SECTION 7. Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials. Certified copies of
31 this resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections,
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4 the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Parish Custodian of Voting Machines in and for St.
5 Tammany Parish, State of Louisiana, and the Registrar of Voters in and for St. Tammany
6 Parish, as notification of the regular election herein called in order that each may prepare
7
8 for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.
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11 SECTION 8. Application to State Bond Commission. Application is made to
12 the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the special election as herein
13 provided; and a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond
14 Commission on behalf of this Governing Authority, together with a letter requesting the
15 prompt consideration and approval of this application.


