17 about 4,000 receive the Gold Award each year; and

21 leadership and planning abilities, and promoted positive values, personal and spiritual  
22 growth, and community service; and

26 Gold Award process; and

28 WHEREAS, Ms. Heidenthal, a 10-year Girl Scout, is the daughter of Karen  
29 and Dave Heidenthal and was a member of Slidell Troop 63. Ms. Heidenthal, a 2010  
30 Northshore High graduate, attends Southeastern Louisiana University, majoring in nursing  
31 with a minor in piano performances. She put her musical talents to work by creating two
