6 A resolution in support of increasing the jurisdictional amount for City Court  
7 of Slidell to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or the amount set by Code of Civil Procedure  
8 Article 1732(1).


9 WHEREAS, the Judge of City Court of Slidell has requested that the  
10 Louisiana Legislature change the jurisdictional amount for the City Court from thirty-five  
11 thousand dollars (\$35,000) to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); and

14 WHEREAS, increasing the jurisdictional amount would improve the service  
15 the Court provides to residents, small business owners and the legal community of east St.  
16 Tammany Parish; and

19 WHEREAS, it would provide litigants in the 8th and 9th Wards of St.  
20 Tammany Parish with a more convenient location for less time and money.

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it fully  
23 supports an increase in the jurisdictional amount for City Court of Slidell to fifty thousand  
24 dollars (\$50,000), or the amount set by C.C.P. Article 1732(1).
