6 WHEREAS, Slidell Charter Section 4-02(C) provides that the City Council
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8 may authorize Assistant City Attorneys; and
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10 WHEREAS, the City Attorney requires assistance to perform the duties of
11 the office from time to time for reasons including, but not limited to, conflicts of interest;

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15 WHEREAS, such assistant is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the
16 City Attorney; and
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18 WHEREAS, the appointment of an assistant presently requires no additional
19 funding from the City of Slidell; and
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21 WHEREAS, should compensation be required, the City Attorney shall seek
22 prior approval from the City Council.
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24 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that
25 assistant City Attorneys are hereby authorized in accordance with Charter Section 4-02(C).
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27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event additional funding by the City
28 is required in connection with the appointment of an Assistant City Attorney, specific
29 approval by the City Council shall be required.
