8 A resolution of the Slidell City Council to grant a one-time exception to City  
9 Ordinance Sec. 27-181 (c), Mona Lisa and Moon Pie, permitting it to parade on Saturday,  
10 October 26, 2019.

11 WHEREAS, the Administration, in their continued efforts to improve and  
12 enhance the social entertainment for our citizens through parade scheduling, desires an  
13 exception to City Ordinance Sec. 27-181(c), to allow the Mona Lisa and Moon Pie Parade  
14 (“Parade”) to parade on Saturday, October 26, 2019; and

17 WHEREAS, Item No. 19-10-3300 has been introduced by the Council on  
18 October 8, 2019, amending City Ordinance Sec. 27-181(c) by changing the date the  
19 Parade is scheduled to ride in future years until the last Saturday before Halloween each  
20 year, which Ordinance is presently in the mandated lay over period; and

23 WHEREAS, the Administration recommends the one-time exception to better  
24 gauge the effectiveness of the change on its parade scheduling and benefit to the  
25 community.

29 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does  
30 hereby concur with the recommendation by the Administration to grant a one-time  
31 exception to City Ordinance Sec. 27-181(c), to allow the Mona Lisa and Moon Pie Parade
