9 and abide by the binding directives of relevant authorities with respect to the COVID-19  
10 pandemic; and (iii) encouraging residents and businesses of the City of Slidell to keep  
11 abreast of and follow the recommendations of recognized health care authorities with  
12 respect to the COVID-19 pandemic.

13 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic requires calm but urgent action by the  
14 world community; and

15 WHEREAS, to such end, the Mayor of the City of Slidell issued a *Local*  
16 *Declaration of a State of Emergency Related to COVID-19* on March 16, 2020, a copy of  
17 which it attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

19 WHEREAS, the residents and businesses of the City of Slidell can do their part  
20 in battling the proliferation of COVID-19 by following the binding directives of relevant  
21 authorities with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and by following the recommendations  
22 of recognized health care authorities with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic.

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council as follows:


