NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it hereby gives public notice of its intent to further study Sections 8-61, *et seq*. of Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell with respect to the permitting scheme for mobile food services and to take such future lawful action as it deems necessary and appropriate with respect to its conclusions.
