5 A resolution giving notice of the intent of the City of Slidell to further study
6 Sections 8-61, *et seq.* of Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
7 Slidell with respect to the permitting scheme for mobile food services.

8 WHEREAS, in 2018, the Slidell City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3916,

10 which established a mobile food service permitting scheme within the City of Slidell; and

12 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3916 was codified in Sections 8-61, *et seq.* of
13 Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell; and

15 WHEREAS, the City wishes to further study the effects of the current
16 permitting scheme for mobile food services, particularly as they relate to otherwise
17 applicable zoning restrictions within the City, the scheme's impact on City commerce, the
18 potential extended or permanent presence of mobile food services in a single location, and
19 the aims of the comprehensive master plan being developed by the City; and

23 WHEREAS, the City is resolved to give notice to the public of its intent to study
24 these issues further and to take such future lawful action as it deems necessary and
25 appropriate with respect to its conclusions.

32 necessary and appropriate with respect to its conclusions.
