8 A resolution supporting the request of the Mayor of the City of Slidell,  
9 Louisiana for Capital Outlay appropriations for the City in the amount of Three Million  
10 Dollars (\$3,000,000) to assist with the construction of dedicated pedestrian crosswalks on  
11 US Hwy 11 at Kostmayer Avenue and Westchester Place to allow pedestrian traffic to  
cross with greater safety.

12 WHEREAS, the US Hwy 11 corridor is subject to heavy traffic, with four  
13 schools (three elementary schools and one high school), a library, and multiple residential  
14 neighborhoods; and

17 WHEREAS, an accident at the intersection of Westchester Place and US Hwy  
18 11 claimed the life of a child attempting to cross the corridor; and

21 WHEREAS, the addition of dedicated pedestrian crosswalks at select  
22 intersections along the corridor will be a significant tool in helping to reduce the occurrence  
23 of traffic accidents involving pedestrians.

25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal  
26 session convened, that it hereby supports the Mayor's request for Three Million Dollars  
27 (\$3,000,000) to construct Pedestrian Crosswalks on US Hwy 11 at Kostmayer Avenue and  
28 Westchester Place to allow pedestrian traffic to cross at these intersections with greater  
29 safety.
