## **RESOLUTION R24-03**

A resolution supporting the request of the Mayor of the City of Slidell, Louisiana for Capital Outlay appropriations for the City in the amount of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to assist with construction of a new sewer force main.

WHEREAS, the City's current sewer force main from Lindberg Pump Station to Waste Water Treatment Plant is an approximately 30-year-old asbestos-cement force main; and

WHEREAS, the existing sewer force main transports approximately one-third of the City's sewer and has broken multiple times in the past few years; and

WHEREAS, due to the amount of sewer that is transported daily, a break in the main results in an emergency and hazardous situation, and repair and clean-up costs are often significant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that it hereby supports the Mayor's request for Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for the City to construct a new sewer force main to replace the existing sewer force main from Lindberg Pump Station to Waste Water Treatment Plant.
