## **RESOLUTION R25-22**

A resolution authorizing the City of Slidell, Louisiana, acting through its Mayor, to execute and participate in any additional settlements reached in the national opioid litigation.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and the entire State of Louisiana has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic;

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has been a litigating participant in legal actions related to opioid harms;

WHEREAS, the Louisiana State-Local Government Memorandum of Understanding, previously executed by the City, sets forth a framework of a unified plan for the allocation and use by public entities in Louisiana of opioid settlement proceeds from consolidated legal actions;

WHEREAS, numerous opioid settlements have previously been reached, and the City has been a participant in same, consistent with Resolution R21-28; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to make clear the authorization of the Mayor of the City of Slidell to continue to execute, on behalf of the City, all opioid-related settlements and documents ancillary thereto, such that the City may participate in same in a manner not inconsistent with the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL,
AS THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA:

The Mayor of the City of Slidell, Louisiana is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Slidell, any opioid-related settlements reached in the national opioid

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litigation, and documents ancillary thereto, and all such prior executions are hereby ratified. The City shall participate in such settlements in a manner not inconsistent with the Louisiana State-Local Government Memorandum of Understanding on Opioid Litigation while the same is in effect.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
