8 WHEREAS, Ordinance 4258 amended the City's Code of Ordinances to

10 establish a process for the administrative adjudication of certain ordinance violations as
11
12 civil matters; and

13 WHEREAS, the appointment and confirmation of one or more administrative
14
15 hearing officer is required for this process, as such a person is the one to conduct and
16
17 make decisions at these administrative hearings; and


18 WHEREAS, the Mayor appointed, for confirmation by the council, Louisiana
19
20 attorneys Scott J. Spivey and Harold A. Buchler III to serve as administrative hearing
21
22 officers for the City; and

23 WHEREAS, Scott J. Spivey and Harold A. Buchler III meet the qualifications
24
25 set forth in Section 2-604 of the Code to serve as administrative hearing officers and are
26
27 willing to so serve.

28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal
29
30 session convened, that attorneys Scott J. Spivey and Harold A. Buchler III are confirmed to
31
32 serve as administrative hearing officers for the administrative hearing process set forth in
33
34 the City's Code of Ordinances, and the Mayor of the City of Slidell is authorized to enter
35
36 into an engagement to provide for the payment of reasonable compensation for their
37
38 services, whether directly or through the juridical entity through which they operate.
